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Tandem Training implemented for women by women in 4 EU countries in frames of the WomInCreativePower project

The purpose was to develop Creative, Linguistic and Socio-cultural skills of women considered to be migrants, refugees and asylum seekers.

The program of WomInCreativePower in partner countries — Sweden, Hungary and Slovenia, achieved a successful tandem training creating inclusive platforms that gather people who identify as women migrants, refugees and asylum seekers. In the non-formal learning participants had creative skills training and peer-to-peer exchange of as socio-cultural and linguistic orientation sessions preparing to enter the market.

The 55 participants of the training in 4 countries come from different contexts and cultural backgrounds: Jamaica, Italy, Bulgaria, North China, Serbia, Vietnam, Syria, Argentina, South Africa, United States, Iran, Pakistan, and Portugal. This allowed the women with different to find a common working language based on the respect of dignity.

Through the online and offline sessions the following outcomes were

- Local informal support networks were created for the exchange of skills and good will,
- Manual guides were developed by the participants themselves, from women, on developing the cultural and social competencies from a non-ethnocentric point of view,
- 7 completed business plans were created in 4 countries, which are be presented to potential donors for financial support,
- A table that gathers information of the participants of the tandem all participants on the skills, knowledge and competencies that each can teach or would like to learn.

Participants of the tandem training have opportunity to take part in activities of the WICP project.
